- Participants **must** be Middlesex University Dubai currently enrolled students
- **Theme: Joy in The Little Things**
- **Deadline of submission:** 17 May 2020, 4:30pm to be sent to *studentactivities@mdx.ac.ae* (Full name, Student ID number, phone number and email address) or through google *link* under category. Email subject: Category (ex: dance, music, photography)

Your art work can be a sketch or painting based around the theme.

Rules

Every participant in the visual art category can submit only one artwork for the visual art category.

The submission must be online. The participants retain all copyrights to their artwork without exception.

Each entry must be original in concept, design, and execution. Any entry that has been copied from an existing photo or image (including a painting, graphic, or advertisement) that was created by someone other than the student is a violation of the competition rules and will not be accepted.

Please refrain from writing your name anywhere on the artwork or behind the artwork. Every participant will be assigned a number, that will be presented to the judges. This is to maintain anonymity of work and to avoid any form of bias.

The participant has to provide a description of the artwork, which should be detailed, clearly identifying the major elements of the work, on a separate word document (60-100 words max).

Formatted as:

- Font size: 14
- Font style: Times New Roman
- Margins: Normal
- Alignment: Justified
- Spacing: Double line

Judging

Each of the following criteria is worth a maximum of 10 points and a minimum of 1.

1. Creativity (shape and integration)- How creative the participant has been in using the object (i.e - to make an artistic statement, to tell a story, etc)
2. Originality of idea - being unique and creating something that is different
3. Detailing - measures how well the project makes its own theme clear to the viewer
- 4 Finishing - refers to the completion of the project and attention to quality

You are free to create your artwork in your own way. Please note your creation does not violate any of the university's policies.
